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What is Pecha Kucha?

- Pecha Kucha is a short presentation.
- It consists of 20 slides and each slide lasts 20s (the whole presentation lasts 400 seconds).
- The slides consist of mainly pictures and there is little to no text. The main focus is on what is being said.

What should you tell?

- Basic information about your university (location, size, fields of study etc.)
- Because the theme of the week is innovation and courage, we would like you to share something innovative about your university. It can be anything: a course, teaching method, invention, a delicious food your cafeteria offers or anything you find interesting.
- Be creative! There are no restrictions for what you can tell (remember, though, that you have a time limit of 400s!).
- The presentations don't have to be formal. The goal is to be informative, but also creative, fun and relaxed.

How to make the presentation?

- You can use PowerPoint or other slide show applications.
- Set the time for each slide for 20 seconds, so that the slide changes automatically.
- Use pictures and as little text as possible (avoid long sentences).
